What is Jesus' *Great Commission*?

The Great Commission

Mission is the name we give to the job Jesus tells us to do in Matthew 28:19-20:

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

When disciples go to faraway lands to make disciples, that's called a mission.

Frontier Mission Kids are Disciples of Jesus

A disciple is a person who

- Believes Jesus is the Son of God,
- Needs and asks Jesus to forgive their sins, and
- Follows and obeys Jesus in their daily lives—
in Bible study, worship, prayer, and service—
to grow to be more like Jesus.



A Disciple's Heart

- A disciple has Jesus' Holy Spirit in their heart to teach and guide them in life and to make more disciples for Jesus (John 14:15-31).
- When a disciple follows Jesus, their heart becomes like Jesus' heart that loves God and people, all people. Jesus said, "Everyone will know you are my disciples if you love one another" (John 13:35).



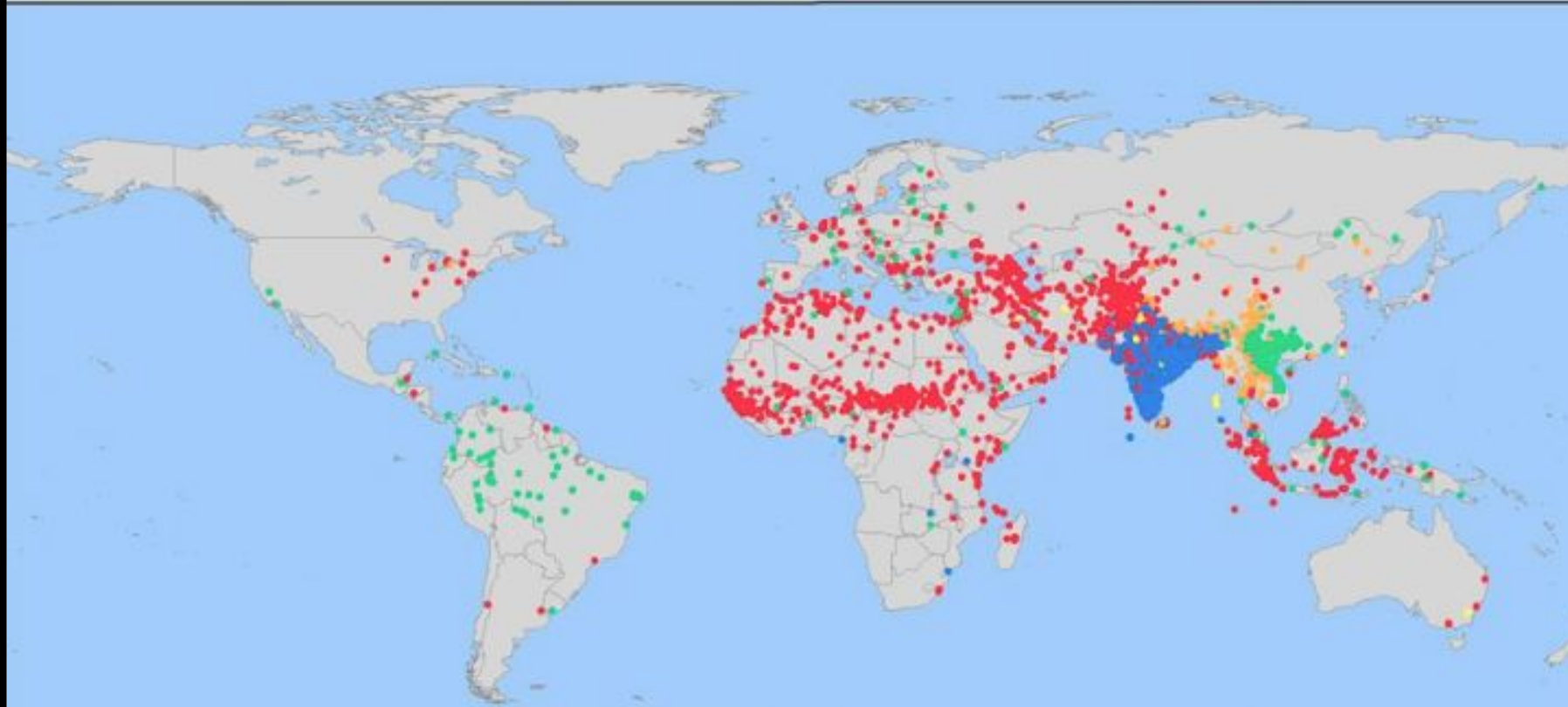
