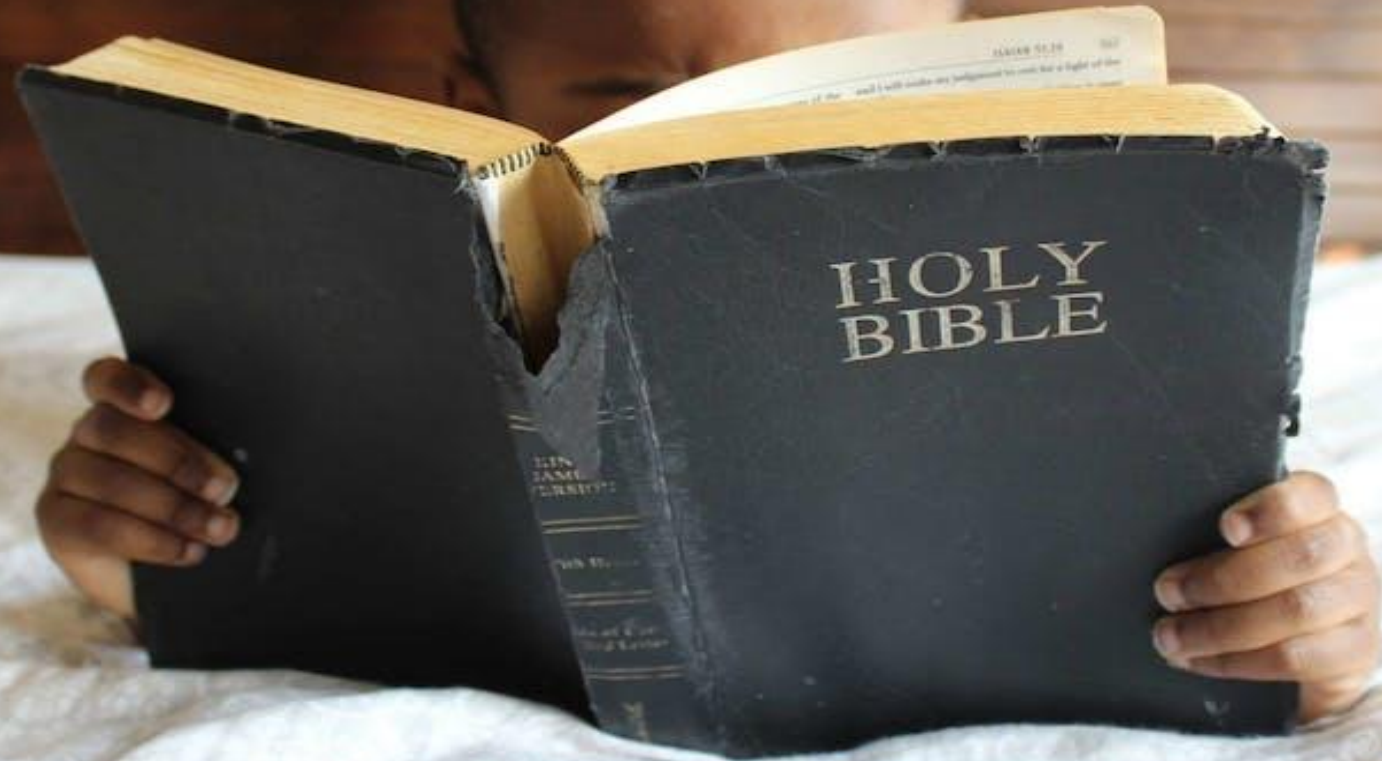

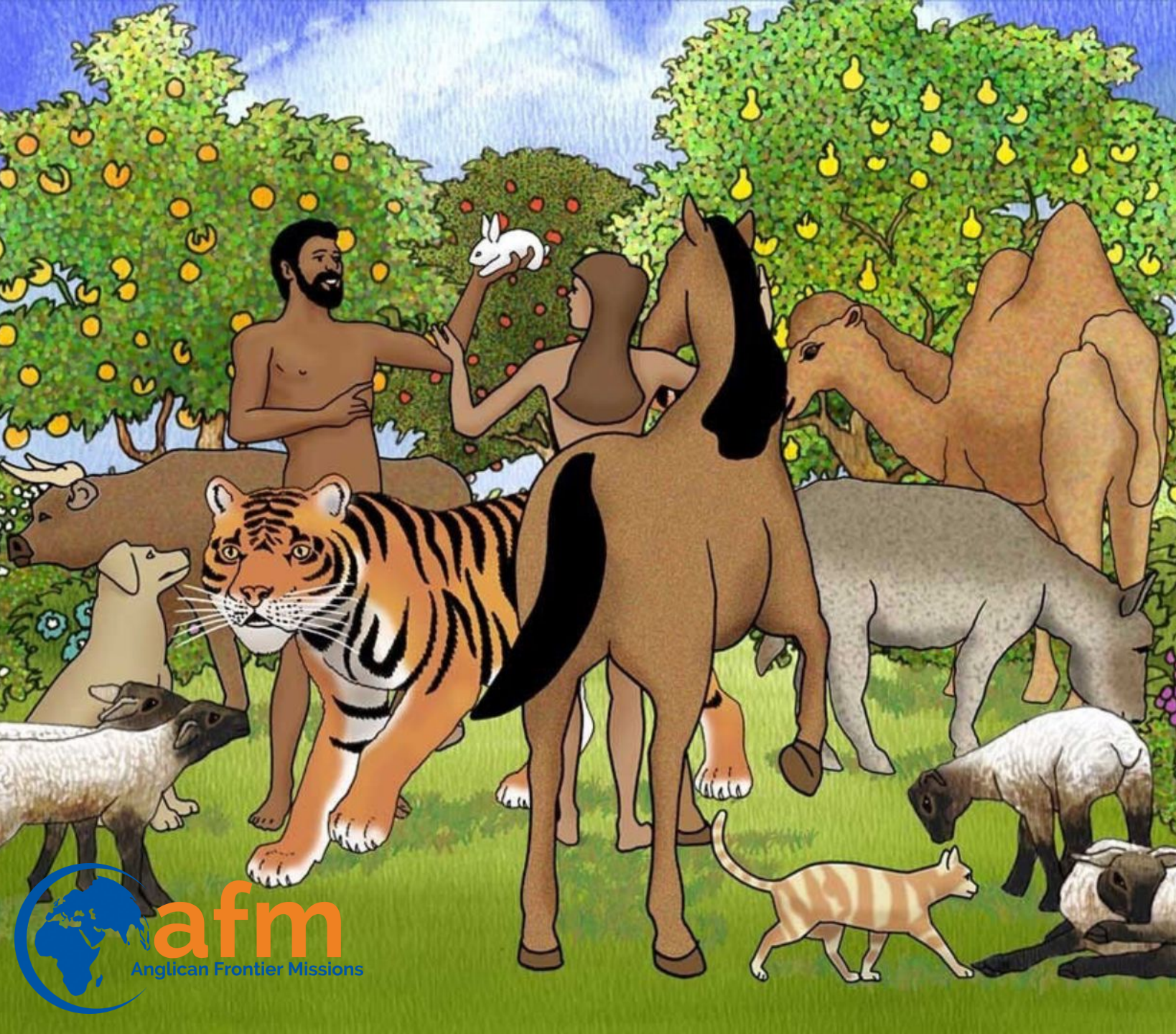

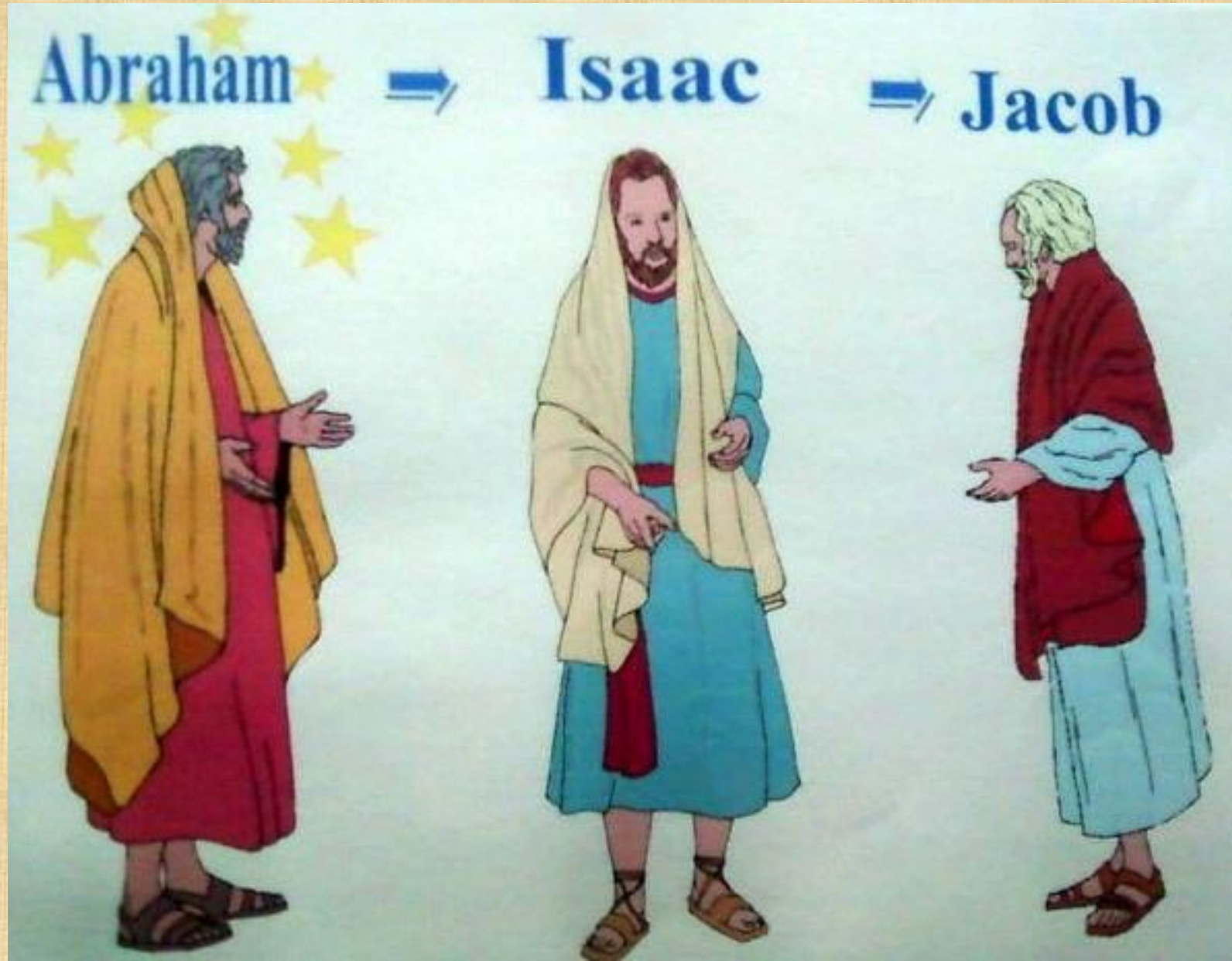

The Lord protected the Israelites by throwing the evil Egyptian army into The Red Sea. The entire army drowned in the sea.

God Parts the Red Sea to Save the Israelites

The Ten Commandments

I. You shall have no other gods before me.

II. You shall not make any idols.

III. You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain.

IV. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

V. Honor your father and your mother.

VI. You shall not murder.

VII. You shall not commit adultery.

VIII. You shall not steal.

IX. You shall not bear false witness.

X. You shall not covet.

The Mosaic Covenant also had about 600 other laws. This Covenant was conditional on the Israelites' obedience.

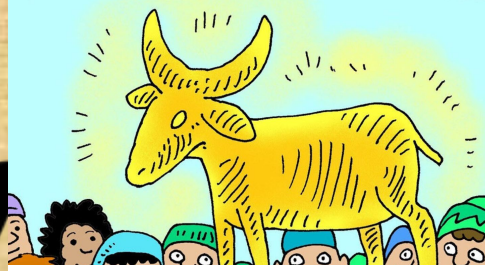

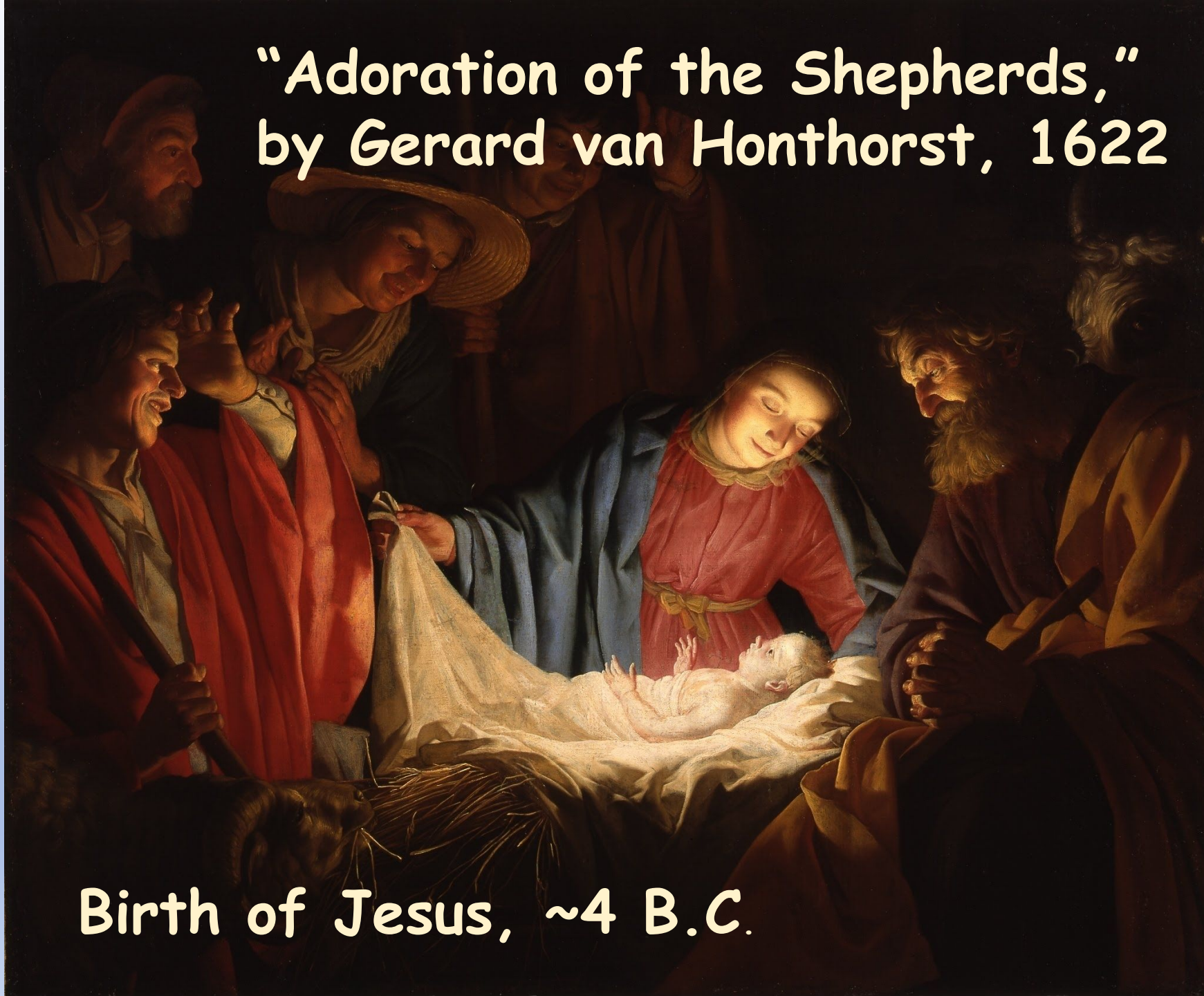


430 YEARS BETWEEN THE OLD AND NEW TESTAMENTS

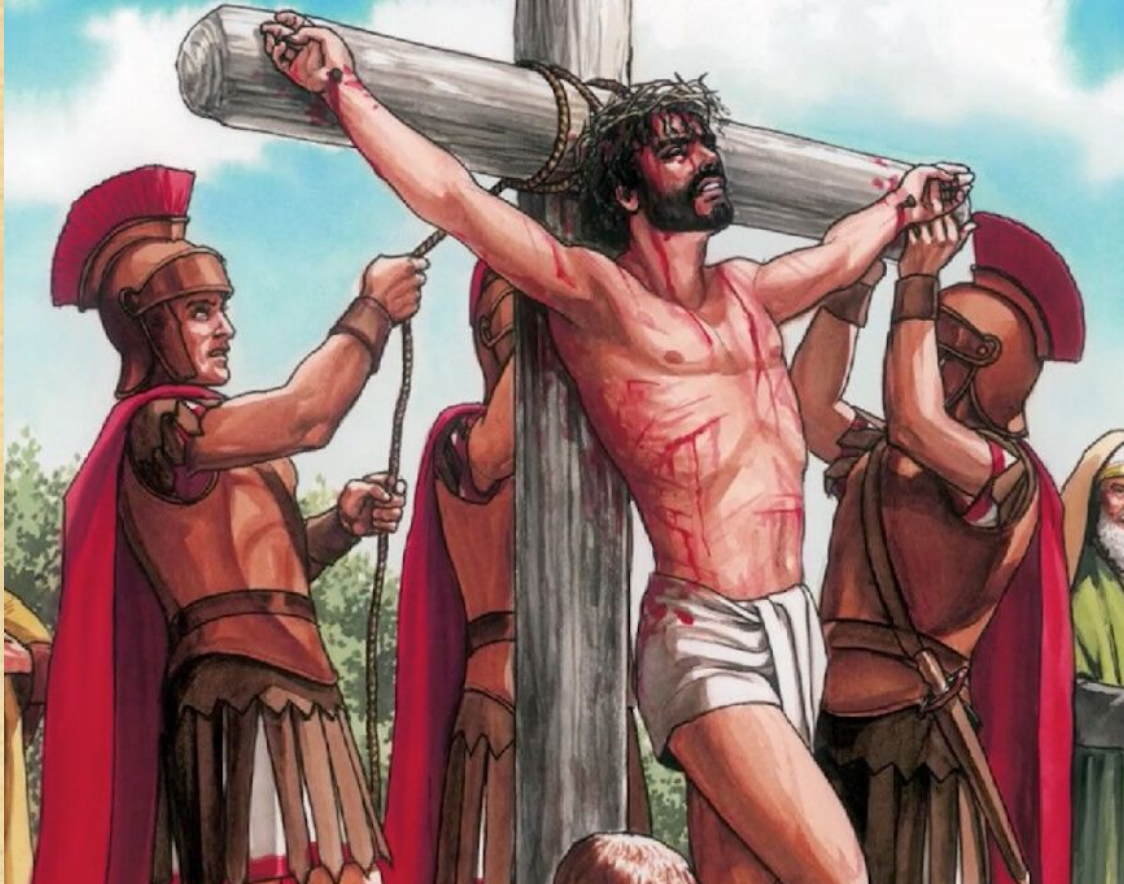
